Primary Elections are **Tuesday, June 26th**

If you are an unaffiliated voter, you will be getting a primary ballot for the first time. Here's what to do with it:

All unaffiliated voters will receive **one** envelope with **two** ballots in the mail (likely the second week of June)



One Democratic primary ballot



One Republican primary ballot

Voters should choose **one ballot** (either Democratic or Republican) to fill out completely and insert in their envelope with the safety sleeve.

Voters should destroy and discard their second ballot.

DO NOT FILL OUT BOTH BALLOTS.

If you submit ballots from both primaries, your ballot will be rejected and your vote will not be counted.

Once you have sealed your envelope with **one complete ballot** inside, you have three options for casting your vote:



Place a stamp on your ballot and mail by Friday, June 22



Place your ballot in a dropbox by 7pm on Tuesday, June 26



Visit a VSPC in your county by 7pm on Tuesday, June 26
